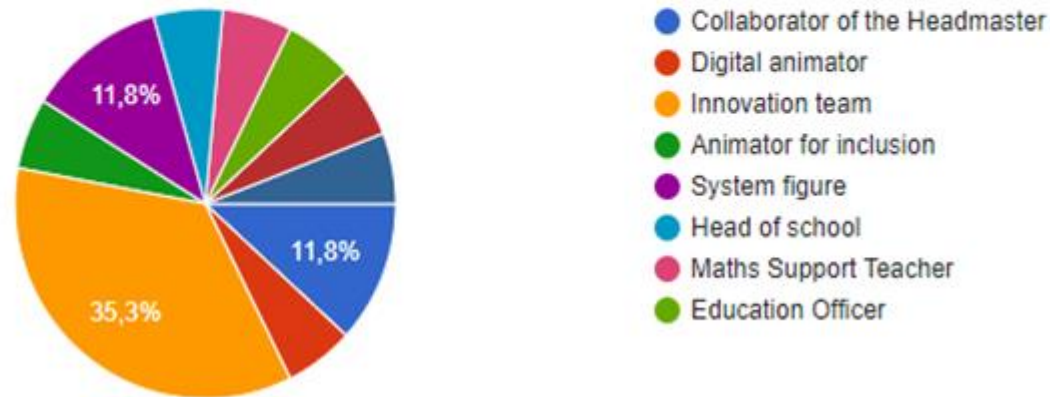

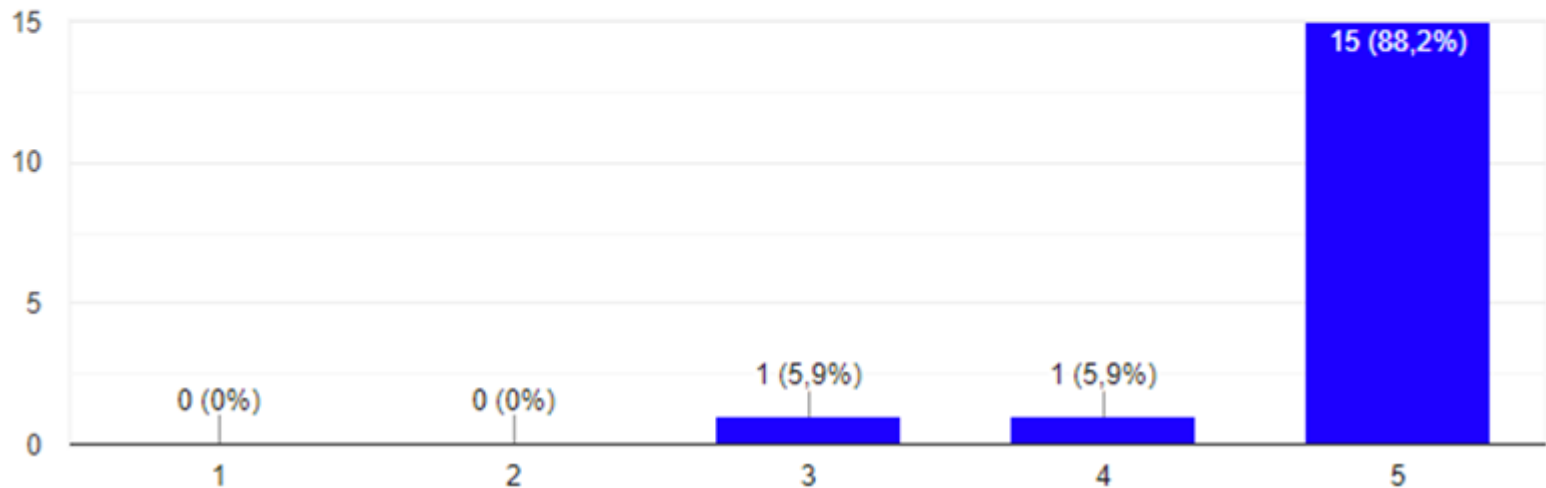


- From the pie chart above one can see that this course targeted educators from various strata ensuring better dissemination!

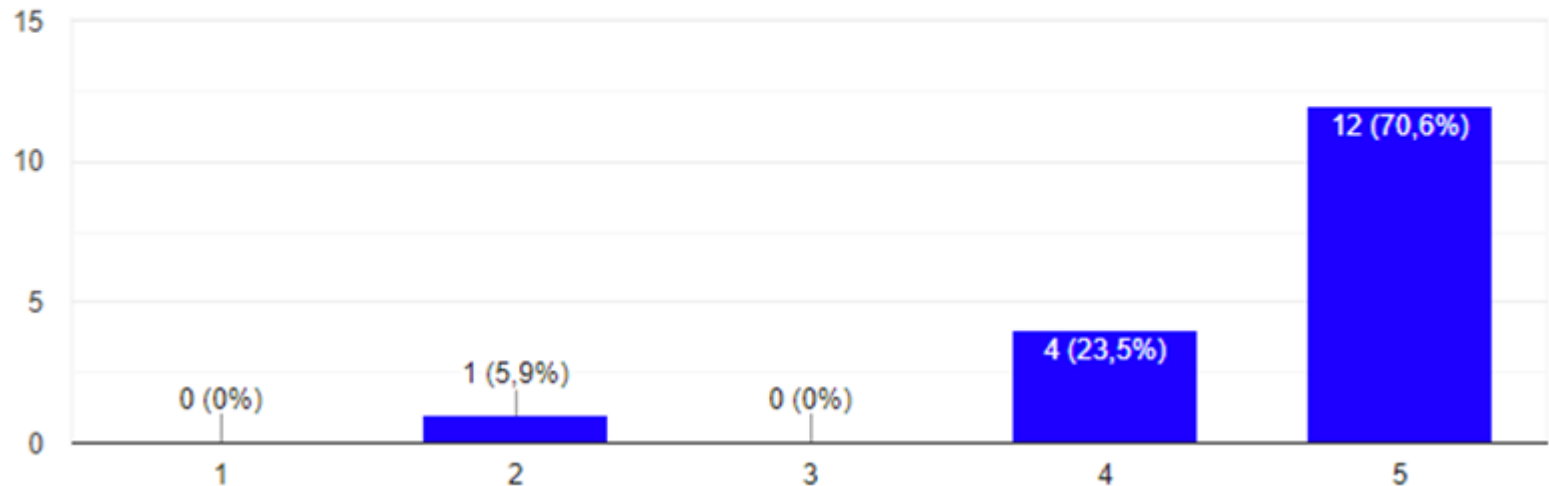


- Most of the participants strongly agree that the location of the course was suitable. One can add that the location was very central with metro only 200m away!

Functionality and comfort of the rooms used

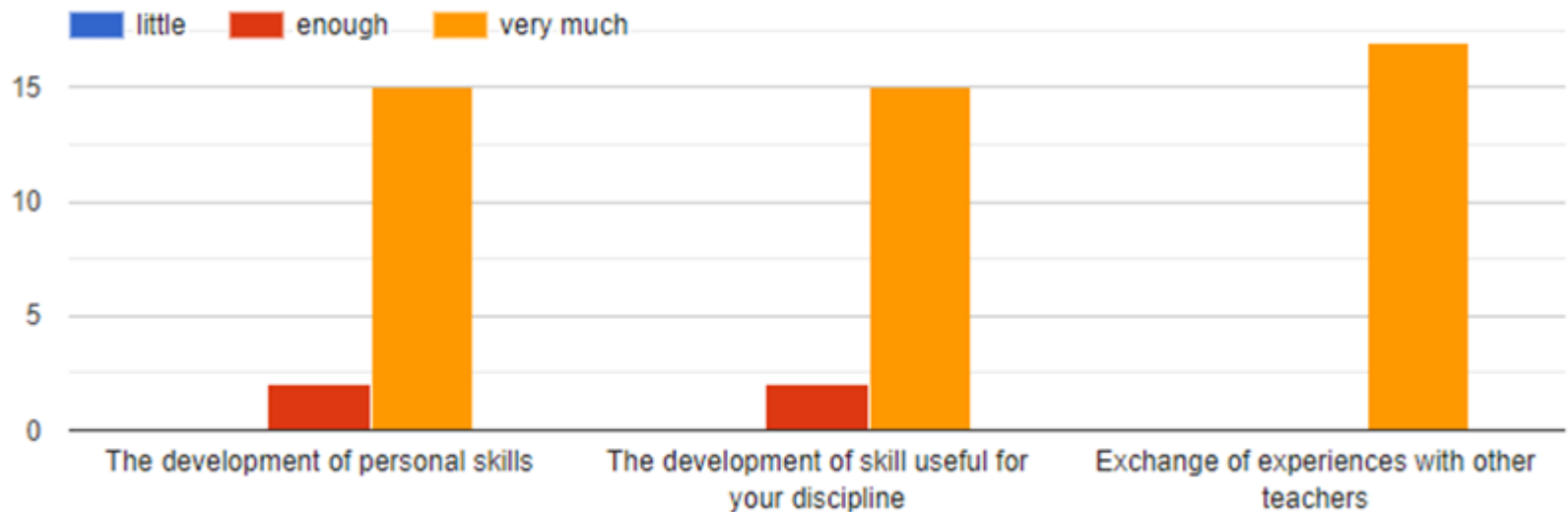

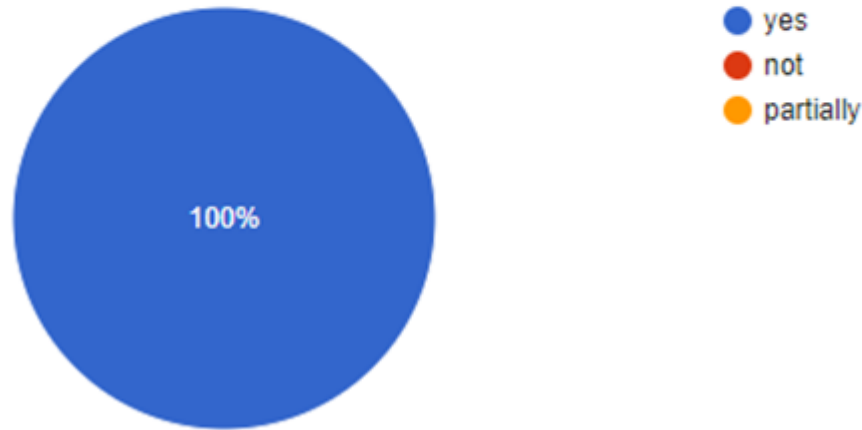


- All participants were pleased or very pleased with the content of the course and the applicability of course content in school curricula.

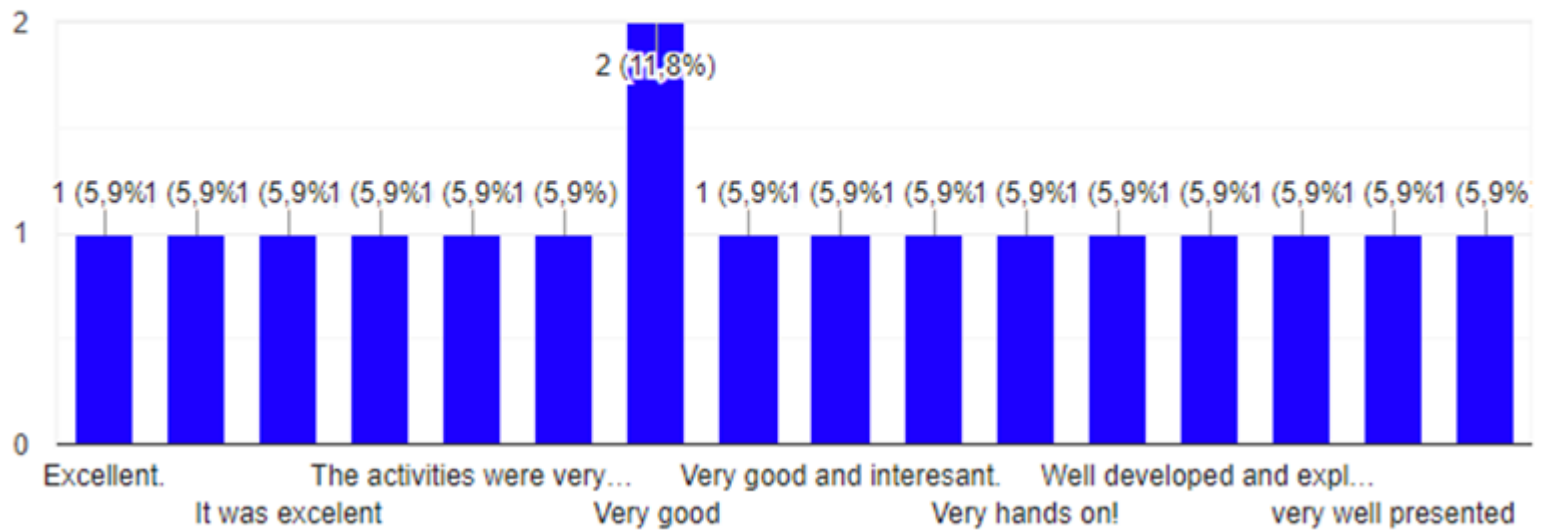

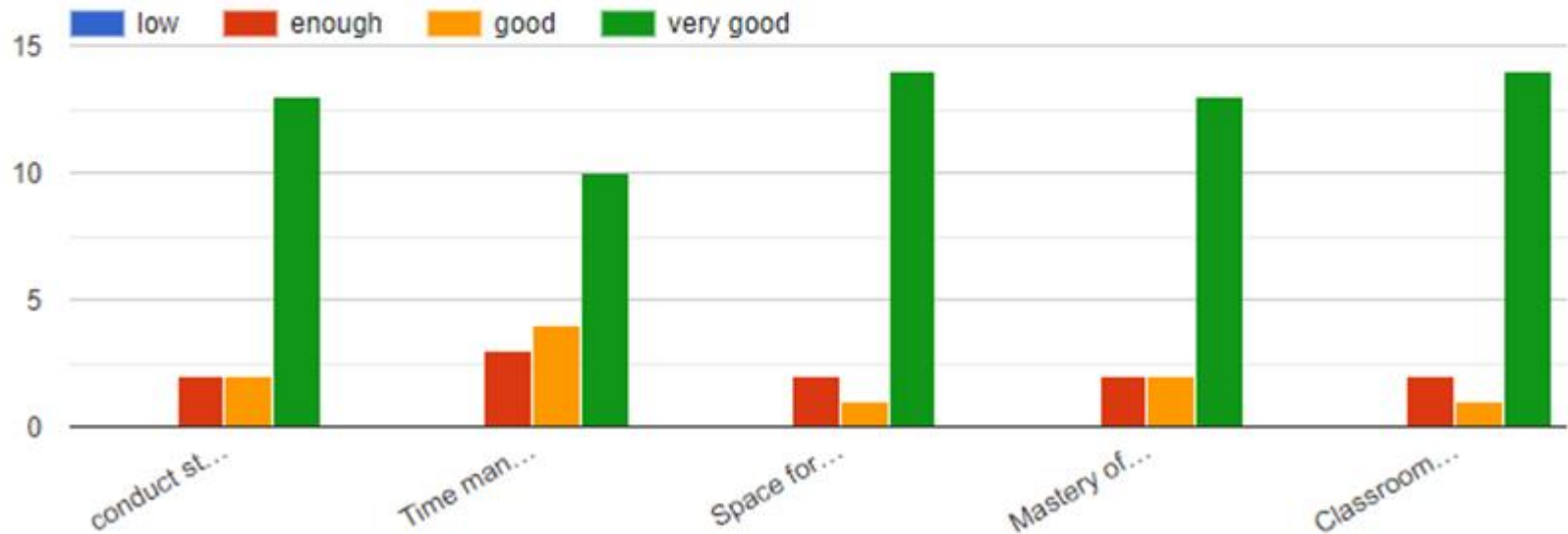

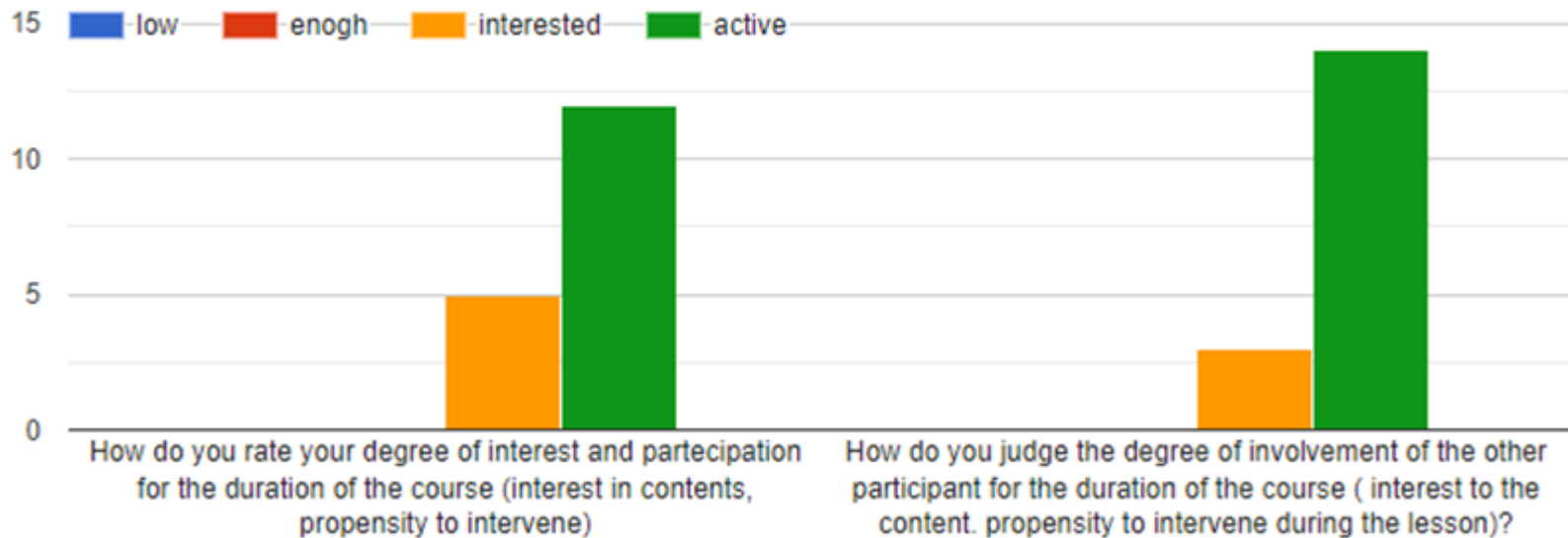
Teaching materials

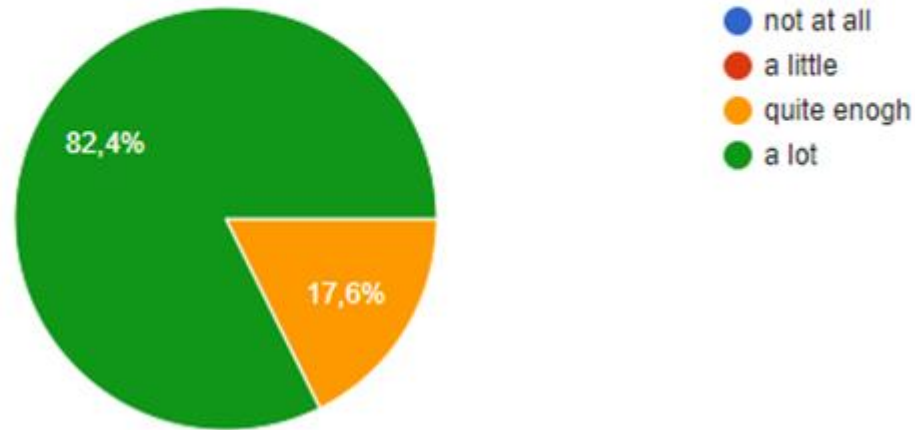

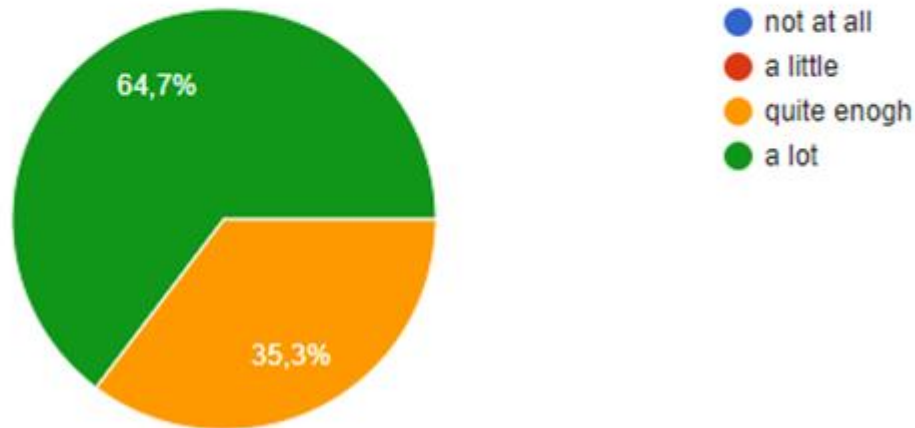


- The pie chart above is evidence of the success of this course where participants valued that what has been learned can be applied in their teaching experience.

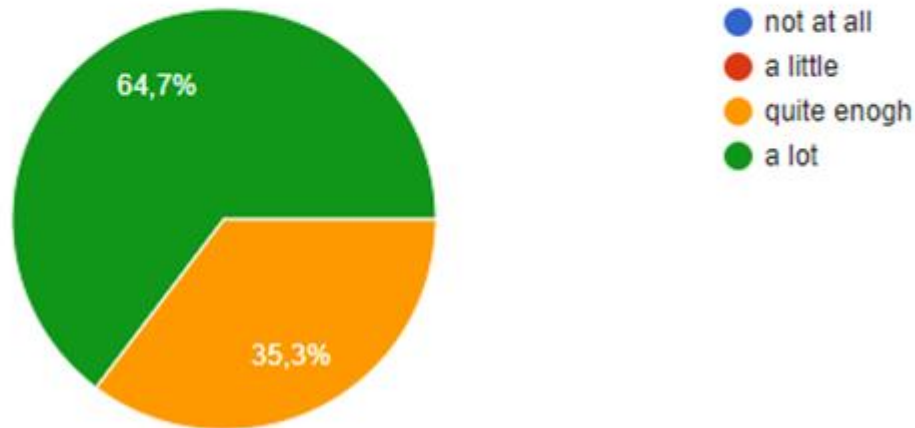

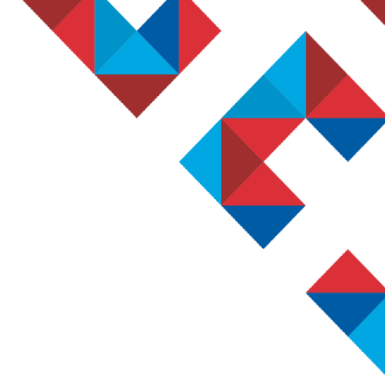

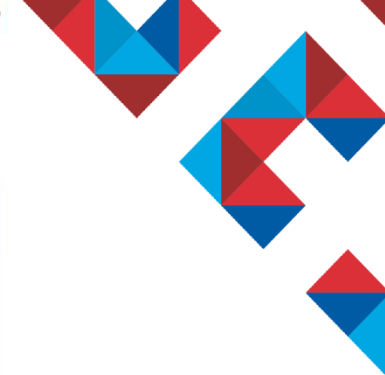
